Project Summary

The Tarong West Wind Farm (the Project) is located within the South Burnett Regional Council local government area approximately 30 kilometres (km) west of Kingaroy and 8 km north-west of Kumbia.

If developed, the 97 turbine wind farm will deliver significant local benefits within the proposed Southern Queensland Renewable Energy Zone (Southern QREZ), through local employment opportunities and community benefit programs.

We're proud to help support the greater community within which the Tarong West Wind Farm will be located.


Upcoming Information Sessions
