

# TARONG WEST WIND FARM

## Newsletter 15

In planning for Australia’s clean energy future, RES acknowledges its rich history. We pay our respects to the Auburn Hawkwood People Aboriginal Coporation and the Wakka Wakka Native Title Aboriginal Corporation as the Registered Native Title Body Corporates of the Country on which the Tarong West Wind Farm is proposed.

### Project Summary

The Tarong West Wind Farm (the Project) is located within the South Burnett Regional Council local government area approximately 30 kilometres (km) west of Kingaroy and 8 km north-west of Kumbia.

The wind farm, comprising up to 97 turbines, will deliver significant local benefits within the proposed Southern Queensland Renewable Energy Zone (Southern QREZ), through local employment opportunities and community benefit programs.

### Project Update - August 2024

#### Background Noise Monitoring

RES has engaged a contractor to undertake additional background noise monitoring for Project neighbours who have expressed interest. The monitoring campaign will take place in two rounds, with the first round expected to be completed by mid-December 2024.

#### Baseline Dust Monitoring

Based on feedback from the local community RES has committed to undertake a baseline dust monitoring assessment along key roads that are proposed to be used for accessing the Project site during construction in areas near the Project. The results will be a point of comparison for future assessments during the construction phase of the Project. This assessment will begin before the end of the year and is expected to continue for a minimum of 6 months.

#### EPBC Process

RES is working to finalise the Public Environment Report for the Project’s EPBC Assessment by the Federal Government. Part of the assessment process will involve a public comment period, currently expected to occur in Quarter 1 2025. We will advise further information on the timing of the public comment period in future newsletters.

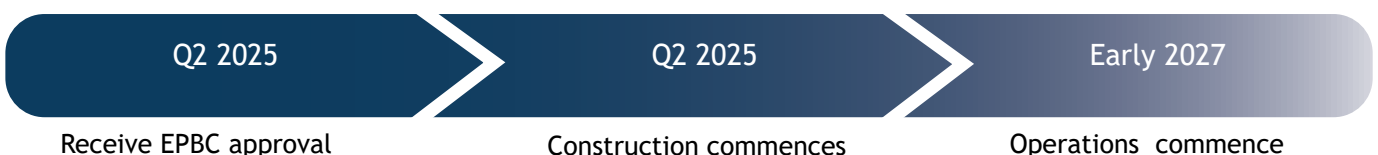
#### Local Success

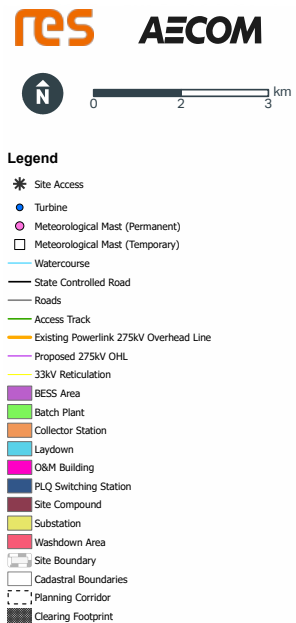
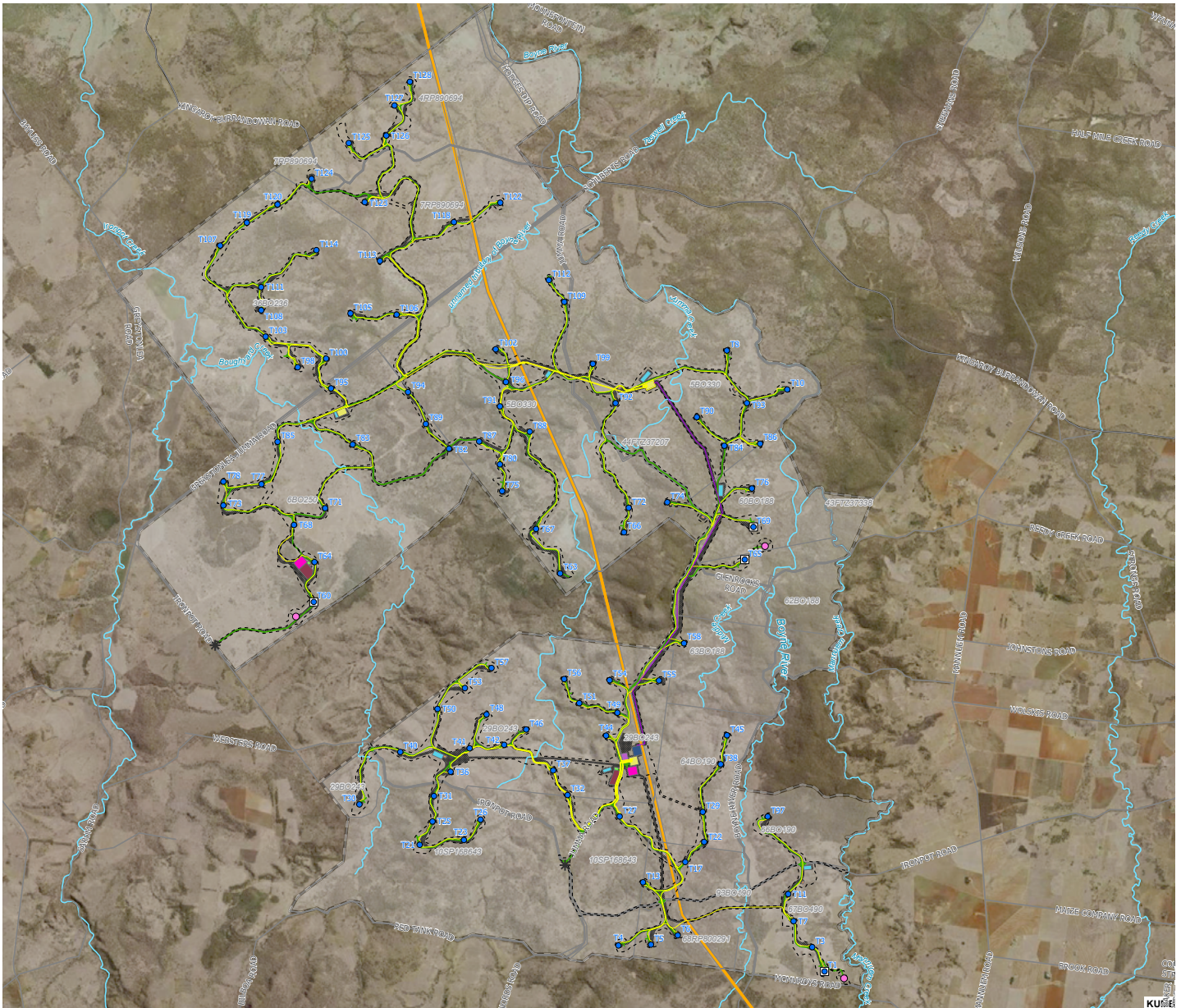


Dulacca Wind Farm
